Robert M. Belden, of Elk Grove Village, Ill., formerly of the 7700 block of Seneca Trail, Bedford Township, Michigan, died after a long illness Tuesday in Alexian Medical Center, Elk Grove Village.

A resident of Toledo until 1970, he was owner of Belden Press and Secretarial Service, Schaumburg, III.

He was an Army veteran of the Vietnam War.

Surviving are his wife Patricia; son Michael T; daughter Kelly Belden; stepson, Michael Morales; parents Mr. And Mrs. Theron Belden; brothers Dean, Theron R., and Glen; and sister, Mrs. Darlene Wallace.

The body is in the Ahigrime Mortuary, Schaumburg, where services will be at 8 tonight.


