A 16-year-old Samaria, Mich., youth drowned yesterday in Sunset Acres Park Lake on M-151 in Bedford Township.

The victim was Robin A Herbster, 10551 Walnut St. Trooper Raymond Rolandson of the Erie, Mich., state police post attempted to revive the boy by mouthto mouth resuscitation en route to Toledo Hospital. The youth was swimming near a raft some 60 feet from shore when he disappeared. The body was recovered in 12 feet of water near the raft.

Young Herbster, born in Toledo, lived in the Samaria area 11 years. He was a junior at Bedford High School.

Born September 17, 1946, to Mr. And Mrs. George (Celile) Herbster, Robin is survived by his parents; sister, Dorothy, at home; brothers George, Mark and Daniel, all at home; grandparends, Mr. And Mrs. Claude Bryant, Bedford Township, and Mr. And Mrs. George Herbster, Toledo.
