Christina J Neuman, 51, of Chicago IL, formerly of Temperance and Detroit, MI, died August 29, 1997, after a valiant fight against breast cancer. She died in her home with her family members and fiancée close.

Chris attended Bedford schools and received both a BS and ME from Wayne State University. She taught sciences in Warren Consolidated Systems for many years, before making a very successful switch to pharmaceutical sales.

Chris was born July 23, 1946 to Karl and Mary (Coleman) Neumann. She is preceded in death by her father. She is survived by her sons, Eric Cardinali of Brazil and Andrew Cardinali; fiancée, Thomas Hobbs of Chicago; mother,

Mary Neumann; siblings, Victoria Oliver of Temperance, William Neumann of California, and Roderick Neumann of Florida.

In her will, Chris established the first scholarship for women studying sciences at the WSU College of Sciences.
