MERICOPA – Wayne T. Pelzer, 54, of Mericopa died Jan. 16, 2001 in Mesa. Visitation will begin at 5 p.m., Friday at Bueler Mortuary, 14 W. Huley Drive in Chandler. The funeral there will begin at 7 p.m.

Mr. Pelzer was born in Little Falls, N.Y. He was a navy veteran of the Vietnam War and received two Purple Hearts. He was a registered nurse and came to Arizona 23 years ago from Toledo, Ohio.

Survivors include his wife, JoAnn; two daughters, Mary Ybarra and Betsy Garcia of Hidden Valley; his parents, Oscar and Jeanette Pelzer of Measa; and two grandchildren.
