PROPOSAL SECTION: STATE PROPOSALS PROPOSAL 14-1

APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL OF AMENDATORY ACT TO REDUCE STATE USE TAX AND REPLACE WITH A LOCAL COMMUNITY STABILIZATION SHARE TO MODERNIZE THE TAX SYSTEM TO HELP SMALL BUSINESSES GROW AND CREATE JOBS

The amendatory act adopted by the Legislature would:

1. Reduce the state use tax and replace with a local community stabilization share of the tax for the purpose of modernizing the tax system to help small businesses grow and create jobs in Michigan.
2. Require Local Community Stabilization Authority to provide revenue to local governments dedicated for local purposes, including police safety, fire protection, and ambulance emergency services.
3. Increase portion of state use tax dedicated for aid to local school districts.
4. Prohibit Authority from increasing taxes.
5. Prohibit total use tax rate from exceeding existing constitutional 6% limitation.

 BEDFORD LIBRARY PROPOSAL
 AUGUST 5, 2014**

Shall the annual tax rate limitation imposed under Section 6 of Article IX of the Michigan Constitution be increased, and shall the Township of Bedford be authorized to levy .25 mills (\$0.25 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value), upon the taxable real and tangible personal property within the Township of Bedford, Monroe County, Michigan for a period of five (5) years beginning in 2014 and continuing through 2018, inclusive, for the purpose of providing certain funding for the Bedford Township Library for general building and grounds operations and maintenance, and for capital expenditures for building and grounds improvements? The estimated revenue for the first year of the levy, if the proposition is approved, shall be approximately \$245,000.00.
