## Solutions for Bedford Township Roads

Results of the Discussion from the Town Hall Meeting June 5, 2014

- Communication, communication, communication It was said many times and load and clear, the Township Board needs to communicate with the Public.
- 2. Coordinate trash pick-up days and vendors in order to save wear and tear on the roads with many heavy trucks working on the same days.
- 3. Change the Road Commission Policy (MCRC) on Special Assessment Districts (S.A.D.'s)
- 4. County Commissioners should reinstate the Self Help Program.
- 5. Fines for overweight trucks should be used on road improvement not be given to the Library.
- 6. Change Act 51, the statute that regulates road commissions and road funding. It is outdated and not effective for current standards.
- 7. Township Board should apply surplus dollars in the budget at end of each fiscal year toward roads.
- 8. Need dollars from local residents for local roads either by millage or special assessment.
- Reduce load limits on roads and enforce them.
- 10. Community needs to coordinate efforts and work together to demand improved road funding, maintenance and construction.
- 11. Reduce speed limits on Samaria, Jackman and Secor Roads this would need approval from the State Police and MCRC who set limits.
- 12. School buses to Monroe Road Elementary should not use Clegg Road as it is not built for that much traffic.
