Warren E. Eyer, 51, of 450 Theodore Dr., Riverside Manor, a counselor and coordinator for Bedford Public Schools, where he also was a teacher for many years, died of cancer at 9:15 p.m. Sunday in his home. He had been ill since December.

Friends may call after 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Rupp Funeral Home where services will be at 11 a.m. Thursday. The Rev. Thomas Macaulay of Carleton United Methodist Church will officiate and burial will be in Maple Grove Cemetary, Dundee.

Mr. Eyer received a bachelor of science degree in couseling and secondary education from Michigan State University, East Lansing, and a master's degree in education from the Uiversity of Michigan, Ann Arbor.

A 1948 graduate of Airport High School, he served with the Army during the Korean War,1953-55.

He had been a driving instructor for Bedford Public Schools for 20 years and was regional administrative officer of Region III for the Michigan Industrial Education Society.

The son of Loren E. and Opal E (Knack) Eyer, he was born Dec. 5, 1929, in Monroe. He was married to Evelyn M. O'Connor Aug. 20, 1955 in Bronx, New York.

He was a member of the National, Michigan and Bedford Education Association.

Surviving are his wife; his mother of Carlton; five sons, David E., who is with the Navy, Mark E. of Monroe, and Eric E., Bruce E. and Stephan E., all at home, and a sister, Mrs. George (Barbara J.) Bergman of Westland. He was preceded in death by his father.
