

# Bedford hall of fame seeks team from 1966

For the first time since the Bedford High School Alumni Association started its hall of fame 10 years ago, it plans to induct an entire team.

Right now, it's trying to find and contact all the members of the 1966 football team — winner of the Great Lakes League championship.

"There were probably 50 total people involved, including coaches, managers, and players," Gene Stock, vice president of the alumni association, said. "Probably 15 of them have gotten hold of me so far."

Mr. Stock said the group is asking the public to help them locate the remaining members of the team.
