GENERAL INFORMATION

Arrival In Copenhagen Airport

Trafalgar operates arrival and departure transfers on a group basis on the scheduled arrival and departure day of your trip at the times specified below. There are no refunds for unused transfers including when due to flight delays or missed flight connections.

Please make your way to the MEETING POINT in the Arrivals Hall, on the right immediately after leaving customs. Your Trafalgar Travel Director will meet you here a few minutes before your scheduled transfer departure. The Trafalgar coach departs Copenhagen Airport at 9am, 12 noon and 3.30pm on the FIRST day of the trip only.

If you arrive after these times and you haven't purchased a separate transfer, please make your own way to the hotel and this will be at your own expense. Should you take a taxi, do ensure that it is an official taxi from the rank outside the terminal building.

Hotel Check-In

Official hotel check-in time in your arrival city is 4pm. Earlier check-in is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed.

Departure From Moscow Airports

Please note the return transfer from the last hotel will arrive at Moscow Sheremetyevo Airport at 5am and 11am, and at Moscow Domodedovo Airport at 5am and 1pm on the LAST day of the trip only. Guests extending their stay in Moscow after the trip who have not purchased a separate transfer through Trafalgar should make their own transfer arrangements.

Gratuities

If you have been pleased with the services of your Travel Director and Driver, you may wish to express your satisfaction with a gratuity. As this is a matter of a private and individual nature your gratuity should be sealed in an envelope and given to each one separately at the end of the trip. An average gratuity for your Travel Director would be Euro 4.00 per person per day and for your Driver Euro 2.50 per person per day. Luggage Allowance

This is restricted to one large suitcase not exceeding 50 pounds (23kg) in weight not exceeding 30" x 18" x 10" (76cm x 45cm x 25cm) in dimension. Hotel porterage of this baggage is included in the trip price. Hand luggage should be one piece per person and should be limited in size so as to fit under your coach seat or in the small overhead shelf. These are the responsibility of each trip member and should be carried on/off the coach with you. Please note that luggage with adjustable handle and wheels will not fit in the overhead compartments and cannot be accepted as carry-on luggage.

Important Visa Information

Visas are required for this trip, and can be obtained by your Travel Agent for a fee, prior to leaving home. Visas cannot be issued at borders in Europe. Please speak with your travel agent at the time of booking to assess your specific visa requirements as some nationalities, including United States citizens, must obtain their visa's before departing home.

Russian Visas

A visa <u>is</u> required for Russia. Please speak with your travel agent at the time of booking to assess your specific requirements. Please verify that the start/end dates fall either on, or outside, your dates of entering and leaving Russia. A start date later than the first day of the trip will result in denial of entry to Russia by the Russian authorities.
